Re: Request for Speed Humps Along Zoe Street Between Buel and Stobe Avenues


Dear Commissioner Cocola:

I am writing with the hope that you can be of assistance with a constituent matter, or in the alternative, forward this correspondence to the appropriate individual within the New York City Department of Transportation (DOT).

On September 25, 2015, my office contacted your office on behalf of residents of Zoe Street regarding the need for speed humps at the above-referenced location. It is my understanding that residents believe that additional safety measures, such as speed humps, are needed and have requested that DOT explore this option to resolve the increased traffic and speeding problem on this stretch of Zoe Street.
