Dear Commissioner Cocola:


I am writing with the hope that you can be of assistance with a constituent matter, or in the alternative, forward this correspondence to the appropriate individual within the New York City Department of Transportation (DOT).

My office has received a request for the resurfacing of Kensington Avenue. It is my understanding that because of a lack of sewers Kensington is flooded during heavy rains. It is also my understanding that the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) installed twelve seepage basins in 2013. However, for the seepage basins to work efficiently, DOT must regrade the street so the water flows towards the basins.

I kindly ask that your office investigate this matter and apprise me of your findings so that I may advise my constituent accordingly.
