We write with respect to the widespread power outages in various parts of Staten Island, which affected more than 10% of Staten Island customers of Con Edison.

While we know that Con Edison teams are still out restoring Staten Island customers, it is not too early to ask for Con Edison's participation in a meeting at Borough Hall in the coming weeks that could serve as a post mortem of this event. We are hopeful that your team will be able to walk us through what happened and why Staten Island was the only borough that experienced widespread outages on Monday, July 20.


We would also like to discuss in greater detail the communication that took place with our offices and the public at large. While we are grateful for the communication that occurred throughout the day and night, some of our constituents expressed concerns that there was no indication of when their power would be restored (restoration times were listed as "pending" throughout the day on the outage map).

The reality is that despite multiple warnings about our power grid and the need to conserve during hot days, many members of the public continue to be in the proverbial dark about the gravity of the situation in general. This means that each time we have a situation we need to do all we can to explain it in great detail so the message is delivered in as many formats as possible.


