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# Substance Abuse Treatment: Definitions

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### **Crisis Services – Medically Monitored Withdrawal:**

Substance use disorder crisis series provide withdrawal and stabilization services in a short term inpatient program aimed to engage and increase motivation and successfully link the patient to the appropriate ongoing treatment.

### **Detoxification:**

A medical procedure employed by state certified medical or substance use disorder providers to remove the effects of a toxic substance from or to free from dependence on one or more substances such as alcohol, heroin, or other opiate.

### **Drug and Alcohol Outpatient:**

State certified outpatient substance use disorder treatment services provided in a community-based setting according to an individualized assessment and action plan based on the needs of the person. Services include individual, group, and family counselling.

### **Harm Reduction:**

Harm Reduction is a practical set of strategies that aims to reduce the harm associated with risky behavior (unsafe drug use), without (necessarily) eliminating the behavior from the individual's life.

### **Inpatient:**

State certified providers of substance use disorder treatment include intensive evaluation and short term (average stay 28 days) treatment and rehabilitation services in a medically supervised 24 hours/day, 7 days/week setting.

### **Medication Assisted Treatment:**

A treatment approach using addiction medications (eg. Suboxone) administered by a medical professional. Medication assisted treatment should be combined with clinical therapy and may be employed in an inpatient or outpatient setting.

### **Naloxone:**

Naloxone is an opioid antagonist that can reverse potentially fatal opioid-induced respiratory depression and is used as part of the initial treatment of suspected opioid overdose.

### **Opioid Treatment:**

A treatment program where methadone or other approved medications are administered to treat opioid dependency. This level of care encompasses medical and support services including case management, counselling, educational and vocational rehabilitation.

## Definitions (continued)

### Outpatient Day Rehab with Alternative School:

State certified outpatient substance use disorder treatment services provided in a community-based setting according to an individualized assessment and action plan based on the needs of the person. Some programs specialize in adolescent services and accredited education in an on-site alternative school.

### Outpatient Intensive:

State certified outpatient substance use disorder treatment services provided in a community-based setting at an intensity of at least 3 hours per day, 3 times per week. Services are provided according to an individualized assessment and action plan based on the needs of the person. Services include individual, group, and family counselling.

### Residential:

State certified residential providers assist individuals with a substance use disorder who are unable to maintain abstinence or participate in treatment without help.

### Suboxone:

Suboxone is a prescribed medication that can help treat heroin addiction and dependence on other opiates. Suboxone is a combination of buprenorphine and naloxone.

### Syringe Exchange Program:

Provides free or low-cost sterile syringes for the purpose of reducing blood-borne pathogens such as HIV, Hepatitis B virus and Hepatitis C virus.
