Blood Drive sites
cannot be too **HOT**...
or too **COLD**!

They have to be **JUST RIGHT!**

We cannot operate a blood drive below 60°! If the temperature is between 60°—63.5° degrees, we have three hours to bring the temperature to the minimum of **63.5°** before we have to shut down the blood drive! If we know that the site may have issues, we can send heaters, screens or seek alternative sites during the colder months.

Please adjust the thermostat prior to the blood drive and help us determine the best way to set-up your blood drive to ensure that we keep the climate within the required temperature range.

**Blood drives sites/locations must be
no less than **63.5°F** and no more than **85°F****
